Ruslana Grima and Nicolai Mallia both win their first Gold Cup Tournament at Eden Super Bowl.

16 year old Ruslana Grima emerged as the youngest female winner yet after qualifying first with a 188.8 scratch average (196.8 with handicap) after the 12 game opening round, and then proceeding to win 5 and draw 1 of her 7 game direct clashes final day. Grima, a member of the Maltese youth team going to the EYC in September, bowled an excellent 189 average overall to dominate her opponents.

The fight for second place was much closer, with Amanda Cini, who had finished second after the first 2 days, losing to Marthese Cossai by a mere 4 pins overall including HC, as Cossai won 5 and drew 1 of her direct clashes. Liliana Spiteri, Sandra Xuereb, Josephine Borg, Mia Bugeja and Natasha Bianchi placed 4th to 8th respectively.

The men's competition was very tightly contested between Clifton Micallef and 2 youths, 11 year old Nicolai Mallia and 14 year old Chris Fenech.

Day 1 went to Fenech with an outstanding 1302 scratch series (217 average) over 6 games, while Micallef overtook Fenech on day 2. Both players were still playing over 200 scratch over 12 games (207 Fenech, 200 for Micallef), but Micallef having the edge due to 12 pins more handicap per game. 11-year-old Mallia was always close by, with a remarkable 183 scratch average (+20 pins handicap per game).

Unfortunately for Micallef, he could not find the same form on the finals day, winning only 1 of his 7 direct clashes; while Fenech and Mallia exchanged places all the way to the last game as Fenech won 5 of his matches and Mallia 4. At the end Mallia managed to overtake Fenech by just 27 pins thanks also to a strong final game of 214 including handicap.

Fenech, who ended as the only player to play over 200 average scratch over the 19 games, had to be satisfied with second place, with Micallef 3rd. He was followed by Edward Xuereb, Clayton Zammit, Melvin Galea, Daniel Grech and Julian Baldacchino.

The day belonged to the youngest player on the lanes, winner Nicolai Mallia, another highly talented youth in the growing local youth bowling community!
