Now let's get to the important stuff from this past eventual month in chronological order.

ISBT Rome Senior Open 2023

To begin July, a handful of our bowlers signed up for the 2023 Italy Senior Open which took place in Rome from the 1st-9th July. These players were Sue Abela, Kenneth Arpa, Dennis Mercieca, Paul Gray, and David Fenech.

From these five, Abela, Arpa, and Mercieca qualified into the semi-finals; Sue Abela qualified for the following stage in 1st place amongst all women from qualifying – she was the only woman to score a 6-game series over 1300 as she totalled 1301 (216.8 average). Arpa and Mercieca qualified in 19th and 21st place respectively amongst the Top 32 males. Paul Gray just missed the cut, finishing in 38th place, while Fenech ended this open competition in 89th place amongst the 146 men taking part.

In the semi-finals stage, the Top 8 where to qualify for the finals stage and two of our three Maltese made this cut: Sue Abela and Kenneth Arpa. Arpa even qualified for the finals in 1st place during this stage!

In this 7-game series, Kenneth Arpa set a new personal best and a new national record for a best recorded 7-game series in an official competition. Arpa shot a blistering scratch total of 1747, averaging a scorching 249.6 throughout.

In the finals, 7 games were played in this ending round robin stage, after which Arpa finished in 7th place and Abela finished the Open in 4th place.

Clash of the Titans: Round 3

The Team Brunswick duo of Sue Abela and Kayden Laganà were the victors of this COTT's Round 3 after the usual 5 games of bowling hosted by Eden Superbowl on July 13th. Abela averaged 214.6 while Laganà averaged 229.0 to claim top spot in this latest edition of COTT.

The runners-up of this July leg were Miguel Xuereb from the men's section and Special Olympics World Games silver medal winner Rachel Chircop from the ladies' section who was clearly still riding her wave of momentum from this past June in Berlin.



The next round of COTT shall be held on August 23rd.

BOV Bowling National Championships 2023

After 24 total games played over 3 unseen and different sport patterns over the course of 3 days, Nicholas Muscat and Sue Abela were crowned as our 2023 national champions. The following is an excerpt from the press release sent out for these BOV National Championships, obviously in collaboration with Bank of Valletta:

18-year-old Nicholas Muscat won the BOV Bowling National Championship to become the youngest male Maltese Champion ever while veteran Sue Abela won her 27th National Title.



In the male division, teenager Nicholas Muscat finished these championships with the highest total scored after amalgamating a total of 5285 (220.21 average) across the 24 games. Muscat finished these championships with a 180-pin lead over the runner-up Kayden Laganà. After finishing as the runner-up in both 2021 and 2022, Muscat has now become the youngest ever male national champion, the only younger Maltese national champion was a 14-year-old Sara Xuereb when she won her first of two female national championships titles in back in 2016.

In his record-breaking run, 18-year-old Muscat also finished this year's BOV National Championships with the best ever recorded average for a full National Championships becoming the first Maltese player to ever finish the Nationals with an average exceeding 220 pins across the entire competition, Muscat eclipsed the record of 7-time national champion Mauro Anastasi who, back in 2018, recorded the best ever average of 219.17 pins.

Sue Abela managed to defend her title for a fifth consecutive year, winning her 27th personal national championships title. In the entire history of the Malta Bowling Association, Abela has won 27 of the 45 editions that took place for the female category. This means that Sue Abela has now won 60% of all female national championship titles in the history of the Malta Bowling Association.



Since the year 2005, Abela was Malta's female national champion for all but two years; Sara Xuereb broke Abela's streak in the years 2016 and 2018 aged 14 and 16 on both occasions. Abela averaged 189.63 throughout the entire tournament and after scoring a total score of 4551 following 3 days of play. The competition was very strong in this division, with Abela and Tiziana Carannante exchanging the lead numerous times with Abela emerging as the champion with a very small 27-pin advantage over runner-up Carannante. Carannante ended the prestigious competition with a total of 4524 with a total average of 188.50. Melissa Swift rounded out the women's podium in 3rd place.

Muscat and Abela are now scheduled to represent Team Malta in the next edition of the European Championship of Champions.


Brunswick Madrid Challenge – Nicholas Muscat

Less than a full week after winning the BOV 2023 National Championships, our male national champion Nicholas Muscat travelled to Madrid, Spain to take part in the challenging Brunswick Madrid Challenge. Muscat was the sole Maltese who participated in this competition.

After qualifying in 19th place from 138 participants in the qualifying stage, Muscat continued displaying his excellent play in the final steps as he kept progressing further and further.

Following successes from Step 1 and Step 2, through which he was already competing among the Top 18, Muscat finished in 12th place after narrowly missing the cut into the Top 8 for Step 4; during this step, he bowled a score of 808 in 4 games.

Muscat averaged 220.6 during qualifying through his 6-game total of 1324. He then just made the cut past Step 1 in the final spot amongst the Top 10 cut before then topping the 18 bowlers in Step 2 by rolling an 898 4-game series. Well done on impressing in mainland Europe once again!



MBA Presentation Night 2023

On July 28th, the Malta Bowling Association held its Presentation Night to present trophies and medals to the winners of local tournaments and leagues from the second half of 2022 till the first half of 2023 (+ league awards too).

During this event held at the St. Julian's Conference Hall, two surprise announcements were made:



The first announcement unveiled new trophies for our national leagues – trophy shields that were presented to the Association by the leagues' sponsor Bank of Valletta. One shield was presented to the reigning champions of the BOV Premier League, Team BOOM, while the other was presented to the reigning champions of the BOV 2nd Division, Emma's Kitchen.

The team members of both leagues were presented with medals to keep, similarly to the other teams in the Top 3, since the shields shall be retained by the Association; the shields feature silver plaques with the winning teams engraved into them to mark their successful campaigns.

Through this Erasmus+ Project, as well as extensive communication with our Greek partners, bowlers who register to take part in this concept shall benefit from sensing technology to help them analyse their techniques during training sessions (ideally with help from their coach).

Using a form of gait analysis, the bowlers will wear light sensors on their wrists and ankles to then help analyse parts of their technique through a designated display. Leagues

Our national leagues kicked off once again, and after some weekly stoppages, leagues are scheduled to progress as per usual for the rest of the month. The next week-long break in the BOV Premier League schedule will be on 18th September; this is due to the Senior National Championships that weekend. The Cisk ESB Doubles League's next break is scheduled for October 4th, while the BOV 2nd Division is not scheduled to pause till its season end following Santa Marija week this August.

After 3 gameweeks in the BOV Premier League, Team Brunswick is currently on top of the standings as the only team to maintain a 100% win rate till now.
